Agenda Item #1 - Call to Order

Chair Joey Yamada called the meeting to order at 6:34 p.m.

Agenda Item #2 – Approval of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Kane Ballard: Route 30 changes have been very helpful and make a smoother trip.

Agenda Item #4 – Committee Report on Public Feedback

Clyde Anderson: At Pro-Rail Nebraska meeting, Sen. Juarez shared about rail proposals and legislative bills, asked about this year's CWS Metro Transit service plan. Expressed frustration over last year's service.

Rondae Hill: Fellow MOBY riders have reported improved customer service experience.

Gab Rima: Appreciate the restoration of the 15-minute Route 13 service.

Agenda Item #5 – Committee Report on Metro Transit Board of Directors

Vice Chair Clyde Anderson:

- March bus ridership was the highest it has been since 2016, completely recovered from Covid.
- Ridership in the West microtransit zone surpassed the North Zone for the first time in March. The South Zone still has the lowest ridership.
- The Board approved the building improvement plan and a contract for boiler replacement.
- Independent reviewer presented results of financial audit. No issues were identified in the audit.
- Board member Clarice Dombeck introduced the idea of occasional joint meetings between the Board and TAC. The board discussed but made no decisions. This will be on the June TAC meeting agenda.

Agenda Item #6 – Metro Transit Staff Report

- The We Make Omaha Future Lab exhibit is open through May 31 in Aksarben and available online at <https://wemake.omaha.gov/futurelab/>. Organizers are seeking feedback and transit is a major component.
- Microtransit
 - Metro's microtransit service is now called Micro Flex // Driven by Metro. Vehicles and outreach materials are being updated.
 - The North and West Zones have been extended. The system map has been updated here: ometro.com/maps-schedules/map.
- No Metro services will run on Memorial Day
- Basic plans for special College World Series service include: an extension of the Green Route, a North Zone Micro Flex stop, and a MOBY and Micro Flex ADA stop by the ADA entrance to the stadium. Detailed maps and plans for the service will be posted online.
- Four Metro drivers participated in the CTAA Roadeo on May 10
- Metro will hold an internal Roadeo and celebrate staff commitment to safety on Memorial Day
- Metro will offer special Memorial Park Concert ORBT services like previous years. Updates will be at ometro.com.
- Metro will participate in these upcoming events:
 - Juneteenth Parade and Freedom Festival on June 13
 - World Refugee Day on June 20
- Comments:

- Rob Sembrat: Would like to hear about user experience on Micro Flex.
 - Committee: Recommend using the app, which is intuitive to request your ride. If you need both bus and Micro Flex, Umo will track your use and not charge you over \$3 for the trip.
 - Micro Flex tutorial scheduled for July TAC meeting.
- Clyde Anderson: How much are high diesel prices affecting the operations budget?
 - Staff: It is having a large impact, but no service is being reduced at this time. We can invite our Finance Director to TAC to present on the 2027 budget. The Board of Directors approves it in September.
